*Regarding the upcoming election of our board of directors, only three vacancies on the Board must be filled. Two officers have indicated that they will not return to the Board on October 1st: They are Past President Joe Puglisi and Secretary/Editor Bill Wyrick. Past elections dictate that President-Elect Craig Stallings will be the candidate for President, and Angie Lowry is due to move up from Vice President to President-Elect. These moves create a vacancy in the position reserved for the Vice President (who is due to become President two years out.) I will remain on board as Past President.*

*Directors serve three year-terms. None are due to retire this year. (The term of at least one director should be concluded each year. We apparently got off cycle when, to fill an unexpected vacancy, we appointed an interim director to a full term. The Board will address this.) Nominations will be accepted from the floor when elections are held at the Annual Meeting on April 19th.*
